CALL FOR ENTRIES

The White House Correspondents' Association is pleased to announce competition for the Edgar A. Poe Award. The award honors excellence in news coverage of subjects and events of significant national or regional importance to the American people.

It is named for the late Edgar A. Poe, a distinguished correspondent for the New Orleans Times-Picayune and a former WHCA president. In selecting a recipient, the judges will be looking for excellence in stories with fairness and objectivity. Exemplary personal qualities may also be considered. In addition, the judges may cite other meritorious entries.

The award comes with a prize of \$2,500 and will be presented at the annual dinner of the White House Correspondents' Association at the Washington Hilton Hotel on Saturday, April 27, 2019.

- * Material must have been published in the calendar year ending December 31, 2018. Entrants may submit a sample of their work up to three stories or scripts. Online entries must be original Web content.
- * Please include a supervisor's certification that the nominee wrote, dictated or broadcast the material on which this entry is based.
- * Entries will not be returned. They become the property of the WHCA.
- * The decision of the judges on all matters pertaining to the award will be final.
- * Entries must be submitted to our website no later than 5 PM, March 1, 2019.
